

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR EXTERNAL CANDIDATES

For Science Stream:

CBSE: Average Grade Point 8.0 and above in ESM. ICSE: 80% and above in ESM.

For Commerce Stream (with Mathematics):

CBSE: Average Grade point 7.0 and above in aggregate and in Mathematics. ICSE: 70% and above in aggregate and in Mathematics.

For Commerce Stream (without Mathematics):

CBSE: Average Grade point 7.0 and above in aggregate. ICSE: 70% and above in aggregate.

For Humanities Stream (with Mathematics):

CBSE: Average Grade point above 6.0 in aggregate and 7.0 in Mathematics. ICSE: 60% and above in aggregate and 70% in Mathematics.

For Humanities Stream (without Mathematics):

CBSE: Average Grade point above 6.0 in aggregate. ICSE: 60% and above in aggregate.

Procedure for admission:

1. Form, duly filled, to be submitted at the school reception along with the payment of Rs. 25/-.
2. List of short-listed candidates will be displayed on the school notice board and the school website on the date specified (after the result).
3. The short – listed candidates will be called for an interaction on the date specified (after the result).
4. The final list of the students admitted will be displayed on the date specified (after the result).

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR STUDENTS OF INTERNATIONAL BOARD

Besides fulfilling the eligibility criteria mentioned above, the students will have to appear for the following:

1. **Admission Test:** This will be based on class X CBSE syllabus of the subjects mentioned as under:

Science Stream : English, Science and Mathematics.

Commerce Stream : English, Mathematics and Aptitude Test.

Humanities Stream : English and Aptitude Test.

2. **Interview:** The list of candidates shortlisted for the interview with the admission committee will be displayed the following day on the school notice board and the website.

3. **Weightage:** Board: 50%
Entrance: 40%
Interview: 10%

The final list of selected candidates will be displayed on the school notice board and website the day following the interview.
